NARCISSISM: A SECULAR APPROACH

The category of narcissism is fashionable. It can be seen everywhere; it is deplored as much as it is shared, but this does not mean that it is correctly understood. In 1936 Lacan started his work on the mirror stage. After 1975 and his seminar *The Sinthome*, he promoted the concept of *escabeau de LOM* (written with three letters). This concerns the production of a narcissism beyond the image but also primary and generic for the speaking beings. The whole question is to know how this narcissism is consonant or not - more or less - with the necessities of socialization.

Dr Colette Soler is a psychoanalyst in Paris. Agrégée in Philosophy at the University in France, a graduate in Psychopathology and Doctor in Psychology, she had her psychoanalytic formation with Jacques Lacan. She promoted the creation and is a founding member of the International of the Forums of the Lacanian Field and of its School. Dr Soler is an internationally recognized clinician and teacher of psychoanalysis. She teaches at the Clinical College of Paris and has published numerous books and articles on psychoanalytic theory and practice in several languages. A few of her books have appeared in English: *What Lacan said about Women*; *The Era of Traumatism*; *Lacan – The Unconscious Reinvented* and *Lacanian Affects*.
